Directions from Tomintoul to Millbank: Postcode AB379JR for SatNav

Whether you come via A9 or by A93 Braemar you will reach Tomintoul.(Alternatively If you come via Ballindalloch if the Grantown -Tomintoul via Bridge of Brown has snow you reach Auchnarrow first)

From Tomintoul take the B1009 towards Dufftown for about 4 miles till you reach **Auchnarrow**, A few hundred yards through Auchnarrow and take the road to the right (or left arriving from Ballindalloch to Auchnarrow) signposted **Chapelton of Glenlivet' ' Clashnoir' and Scalan**. Follow this road for approx 2.5 miles and the top of the track for Millbank on the left and just past the (green) local hall which will be on your right. There is a bin shed at the end with a **red tin** roof and the metal gate is signed **Millbank** . The house is at the end of this track and quite visible

IMPORTANT:" DARK SKIES" (see link above) **Millbank is in a designated 'Dark Sky' location.As a courtesy to local Stargazers, please keep all lighting to a minimum on starry nights. Close curtains and blinds or step outside yourselves and enjoy. Thank you**
